

**ORDINANCE NO. 2014-092**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH VERNON NAGEL OF NAPOLEON, OHIO FOR SANITARY SEWER REPLACEMENT FOR SUTTON PLACE AND GREENDALE AVENUE, PROJECT NO. 35649900, AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR SAID PROJECT, AS WELL AS THE EAST MELROSE AVENUE WATERLINE PROJECT NO. 35741300, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Service-Safety Director of the City of Findlay be and he is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Vernon Nagel of Napoleon, Ohio for the Sutton Place and Greendale Avenue sanitary sewer replacement project.



SECTION 2: That the following sums be and the same are hereby appropriated:

FROM:	Sewer Fund	\$ 200,000.00
TO:	Sutton Place & Greendale Avenue Sanitary Sewer Replacement, <i>Project #35649900</i>	\$ 200,000.00

FROM:	Water Fund	\$ 115,000.00
TO:	E. Melrose Avenue Waterline <i>Project #35741300</i>	\$ 115,000.00

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to appropriate said funds so that construction, contingency, and inspection costs for aforementioned projects may be paid and the project may proceed expeditiously,

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
