

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-093



AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO, TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT(S) TO FARM APPROXIMATELY ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE (165) ACRES IN THE VICINITY OF THE AIRPORT, APPROXIMATELY SIXTY-THREE (63) ACRES IN THE VICINITY OF THE RESERVOIR, AND APPROXIMATELY TWENTY-THREE AND NINE TENTHS (23.9) ACRES OF LAND ALL OWNED BY THE CITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Director of Public Service of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and he is hereby authorized to advertise for bids and enter into a lease agreement(s) for farmland area owned by the City of Findlay, for a period of three (3) years, beginning in calendar year 2015.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to secure said bids so that said lease agreement may be entered into prior to the 2015 farming season to run through calendar years 2017.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
