

**ORDINANCE NO. 2014-101**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**



BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the following sums be and the same are hereby appropriated:

FROM:	Hancock Park District Grant	\$ 9,000.00	
TO:	Bandshell Improvements #31948100		\$ 9,000.00
FROM:	Water Fund (insurance proceeds)	\$ 991.74	
TO:	Water Distribution Department #25053000-other		\$ 991.74
FROM:	General Fund (insurance proceeds)	\$ 2,456.00	
TO:	Health Department #21030000-other		\$ 2,456.00

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to appropriate said funds so that the grant funds received for the improvements to the band shell at Riverside Park may be expended, so that funds received from an insurance payment for additional repairs to a City vehicle, and also payment for the theft of a trailer housed at the Health Department may be expended,

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
