ORDINANCE NO. 2014-104

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A CERTAIN ALLEY (HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS EAST LINCOLN STREET ALLEY VACATION) IN THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, a petition has been presented to Council for vacating the north/south alley between Lots 594 and 595 in the S&P Carlin's Addition from East Lincoln Street south to the north right-of-way line of the first intersecting east/west alley, and;

WHEREAS, Council upon approval and recommendation of such vacation by the Planning Commission of the City of Findlay, Ohio, is satisfied that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the following described alley be and the same is hereby vacated:
