## **ORDINANCE NO. 2013-011**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT (CONTRACT) WITH THE YMCA TO OPERATE THE RIVERSIDE SWIMMING POOL FACILITY AND ASSOCIATED YMCA PROGRAMS FOR PUBLIC AND RECREATIONAL USE FOR THE CITY OF FINDLAY FOR THE 2013 SEASON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Administration and Council has determined that financially it is not feasible for the City of Findlay to operate the Riverside Swimming Pool facility and associated YMCA programs for public and recreational use because of the subsidy that is necessary from the General Fund to pay for said services, and:

WHEREAS, Council has received a proposal from the YMCA to operate the Riverside Swimming Pool facility and associated YMCA programs for public and recreational use, and this is the most cost effective way to keep these services operating for the benefit of the citizens of the City of Findlay as well as Hancock County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Director of Public Service of the City of Findlay, Ohio, be and he is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement (contract) with the YMCA for the operation of the Riverside Swimming Pool and associated YMCA programs for public and recreational use for the 2013 season.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to enter into said agreement so that the swimming pool and associated YMCA programs may be up and running for the 2013 season.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage

and approval by the Mayor.
