

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-066

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO EXECUTE THE NECESSARY GRANT APPLICATION(S) AND/OR AGREEMENT(S) FOR THE AIP-24, AIRFIELD ELECTRICAL AND DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS GRANT FUNDS FROM THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION (FAA), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City is in the process of securing a grant from the Federal Aviation Administration in the estimated amount of fifty-five thousand nine hundred fifty-three dollars and no cents (\$55,953.00), and;


WHEREAS, said grant along with the City's matching share of six thousand two hundred seventeen dollars and no cents (\$6,217.00) will be used for airfield electrical and drainage improvements.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Service-Safety Director of the City of Findlay be and he is hereby authorized to sign the necessary grant applications and agreements for the AIP-24 grant from the Federal Aviation Administration.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to advertise for said bids and secure said contract(s), as well as sign the grant application so that this project may proceed on an expedited basis.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
