

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-085

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1: That the following sums be and the same are hereby appropriated:

FROM: Revolving Loan Fund	\$ 3,297.86
TO: General Expense #21010000-449400	\$ 3,297.86
FROM: General Fund (Donations)	\$ 1,683.10
TO: Safe Kids Project #31924200	\$ 1,683.10
FROM: FAA Grant	\$ 1,032.00
FROM: Capital Improvements – CIT	\$ 115.02
TO: Airport AIP-24 Project #35233000	\$ 1,147.02


SECTION 2: That the Auditor of the City of Findlay, Ohio is hereby authorized to draw three thousand two hundred ninety-seven dollars and eighty-six cents (\$3,297.86) from the Revolving Loan Fund Account held at Fifth Third Bank.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to appropriate said funds so that Hancock Regional Planning Commission may be paid for their expenses/staff time for RLF Administration for October 2013 through November 2013, so that child safety efforts through the Safe Kids Program may continue, and so that grant funds received from the FAA may be utilized,

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
