An updated annual overview of the debt outstanding as of 12/31/2012








TOTAL DEBT as of 12/31/12 is \$40,683,176







GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

- Current allocation is 16% of the net City Income Tax
- Debt payments projected at 33% of revenue
- Council's \$1.5MM transfer into Capital Improvements reduced debt payments to 21% of 2013 revenue
- One potential advance refunding on the 2004 fire improvements debt issue
- Capital plan should look 10 years ahead for major projects so we can reserve debt capacity
- Back- Loaded debt creates a long term challenge



WATER FUND

- Debt projected at 25% of available revenues after capital plans
- Debt issuance could be considered with regard to management of the rate structure
- May need 1 year note for 2013 'Clear Well' project
- One potential advance refunding of a 2004 issue
- One potential current refunding of a 2003 issue



WPC (SEWER) FUND

- Debt projected at 50% of available revenues after capital plans
- No debt should be issued on this fund until 2018
- Cash flow of this fund needs carefully managed
- May need 1 year note for 2013 'Bar Screen' project
- One potential advance refunding of a 1996 issue



SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS

- Currently two debt issuances outstanding; Hunters
 Creek and a Sidewalk issue
- Must remember Special Assessments paid through real estate tax collections; however, are fully backed by the City of Findlay
