There are the flashing lights and street lights at Swing and Broad however it is still rather difficult to see pedestrians when it is dark outside or even more so when it raining. There is a security officer at the crosswalk before and after school. When the security officer is present, there does not to be as much problem at Swing Ave.

There is a stop light at College and Broad which is the only entrance for cars to and from the front parking lot. There are also crosswalks at this intersection.

There is a stop light at Broad Ave and West Foulke Ave.

At Davis Street and Broad there is a marked crosswalk with signage to "Stop when occupied".

Visibility in the mornings when all the cars and students are arriving does make it difficult to see. Cars will stop along Broad Ave in random places and let students out.
