ORDINANCE NO. 2018-098

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO, TO APPLY FOR A COMMUNITY PARK IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM GRANT THROUGH THE HANCOCK PARK DISTRICT FOR RESTROOM RESTORATION AND REPLACEMENT OF OUTDOOR GRILLS WITHIN THE CITY PARK SYSTEM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Director of Public Service of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and he is hereby authorized to apply for a Community Park Improvement Program grant through the Hancock Park District for restroom restoration to include concrete repair, sink, toilet, stalls, flooring and lighting replacement in both the men's and women's restrooms and to replace several outdoor grills within the City parks system, and;

SECTION 2: That all labor for the aforementioned project will be performed by the Public Works Department, and;

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to apply for said grant funds so that they may be utilized within the City park system.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
