The lowest and best base bid was received from Newcomer Concrete of Norwalk, Ohio in the amount of nine hundred seventy thousand dollars one hundred sixty dollars and ninety cents (\$970,160.90). In addition, three alternates were included in the bid package which would bring the total contract amount to one million eighty-eight thousand nine hundred thirty-three dollars and fifteen cents (\$1,088,933.15).
