ORDINANCE NO. 2018-120

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY TO ENTER INTO A RENEWAL CONTRACT WITH FIRST INSURANCE GROUP (PREVIOUSLY KNOWN AS CORPORATE ONE BENEFITS) TO PROVIDE BROKER SERVICES AS IT RELATES TO THE CITY OF FINDLAY HEALTH INSURANCE PLAN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council previously authorized through the adoption of Ordinance No. 2015-088 to allow Findley Inc. (previously known as Findlay Davies Inc.) to make a Request for Proposals (RFP) for brokerage services for the City of Findlay, Ohio's health insurance plan, and:

WHEREAS, Council is desirous of hiring a qualified broker to broker administrative services as it relates to the City of Findlay health insurance plan, and:

WHEREAS, Findley, Inc. recommended First Insurance Group (previously known as Corporate One Benefits) to provide broker services as it relates to the City of Findlay health insurance plan,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor of Findlay, Ohio be and is hereby authorized to enter into a renewal contract with First Insurance Group to provide broker services to the City of Findlay as it relates to the City of Findlay health insurance plan.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to authorize said contract to secure insurance broker services as to not interrupt the administration of the plan.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
