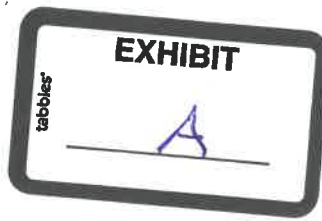

**ORDINANCE NO. 2018-058, AS AMENDED**

**AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF TWO (2) CERTAIN STREETS (HEREINAFTER REFERED TO AS CARROL STREET AND BENTON STREET VACATION) IN THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO.**

WHEREAS, five (5) members of Council have requested legislation to be prepared vacating a portion of certain streets to be vacated as set forth herein, and;

WHEREAS, Council is satisfied that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the following described streets be and the same is hereby vacated:

Situated in the City of Findlay, County of Hancock and State of Ohio:

Being all of Carrol Street as platted in the Cory, Daniels, et al Addition to East Findlay, together with that part of Benton Street from Hawthorne Road to Carrol Street in the Morning Heights Subdivision, Findlay, Ohio.

SECTION 2: That the aforesaid vacation is hereby made subject to the preservation of the public utilities right-of-way, in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 723.041 including an easement is reserved for all sanitary and/or storm sewer lines in said vacated right-of-way.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period provided by law.
