

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-075

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO SIGN THE NECESSARY GRANT APPLICATIONS AND AGREEMENTS WITH THE OHIO AIRPORT MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE TAXIWAY A REHABILITATION PROJECT AND THE RUNWAY 7/25 CRACK SEAL AND REMARKING PROJECT AT THE CITY OF FINDLAY AIRPORT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City has secured grant funds from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to cover the ninety percent (90%) of the aforementioned projects and now desire to apply for the Ohio Airport Matching Grant Program with the Ohio Department of Transportation Aviation to reduce the City's share from ten percent (10%) to five percent (5%) estimated amount of nine thousand seven hundred nine dollars and fifty cents (\$9,709.50).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1: That the Service Director be and he is hereby authorized to sign said grant applications and enter into an agreement or agreements for the Taxiway A Rehabilitation Project and the Runway 7-25 Crack Seal and Remarking Project at the City of Findlay Airport.

SECTION 2: That there is hereby appropriated said sum of nine thousand seven hundred nine dollars and fifty cents (\$9,709.50) for the aforementioned project.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to secure said contracts as well as sign the grant application so that this project may proceed on an expedited basis.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
