MINUTES OF THE FINDLAY CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION November 6, 2019

The Civil Service Commission met on Wednesday, November 6, 2019, in Conference Room 1 located on the third floor of the Municipal Building. Those present at the meeting were Civil Service Commission members – Tom Kemp and Jeff Fort, and Deidre Ramthun, Clerk to the Commission; from the City of Findlay – Don Essex, Human Resources Director. Commission member Chuck Clapper is on vacation.

A. Approval of Minutes:

A motion was made by Jeff Fort that the minutes from the September 25, 2019 meeting be approved as circulated. Said motion was seconded by Tom Kemp, unanimously approved, motion carried, and minutes adopted.
