

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-100

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Findlay has undertaken a lead role in the public safety software platform change to Tyler, and;

WHEREAS, data sharing between the City and County is one objective of the project, and;

WHEREAS, license agreements were required for the County to access the servers, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Findlay sought reimbursement for the license cost.


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1: That the following sums be and the same are hereby appropriated:

FROM:	General Fund	\$ 6,770.00
TO:	Tyler Technology Public Safety Hardware and Software #31977900	\$ 6,770.00

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to appropriate said funds so that Microsoft License purchases required by the County that the City had purchased may be reimbursed back into the CAD project.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
