Preliminary Consent Legislation

Ordinance # 2019-111
County/Route/Section: D01 GR FY2020

The following is an <u>ordinance</u> enacted by the <u>City</u> of <u>Findlay</u>, <u>Hancock</u> County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Local Public Agency (LPA), in the matter of the stated described project.

SECTION I - Project Description

WHEREAS, the LPA has identified the need for the described project:

This project proposes to upgrade and/or replace guardrail at various locations in the ODOT District 1 area including the following location which is located in the City of Findlay.

 Guardrail at the Trenton Avenue (US 224) intersection with Broad Street as it wraps around Broad Street to where it ends on Broad Street.

WHEREAS, a portion of the described project is within the City corporation limits.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City of Findlay of Hancock County, Ohio.

SECTION II - Consent Statement

Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

SECTION III - Cooperation Statement

The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

ODOT and FHWA shall assume and bear 100% of the necessary costs of the State's highway improvement project. In the event that the City requests certain features or appurtenances to be included within the State's highway improvement project's design and construction, and which features and appurtenances are determined by the State to be not necessary for the State's project, the City shall contribute 100% of the cost of those items.

SECTION IV - Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement

The LPA agrees that all right-of-way required (if applicable) for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations. The LPA also understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs.

The LPA agrees that all utility accommodations, relocations and reimbursements will comply with the current provisions of 23 CFR 65 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

SECTION V - Maintenance

Maintain the right-of-way and keep it free of obstructions, and hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

SECTION VI - Authority to Sign City Administrator of said City of Findlay is hereby empowered on behalf City of Findlay to enter into agreements with the Director of Transportation of the necessary to complete the above described project.

Attested: ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure to expedite the highway

project(s) and to promote highway safety. Following appropriate legislative action, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
