

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-047

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR THE SERVICE DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO APPLY WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AVIATION AIRPORT GRANT PROGRAM, AND IF AWARDED, ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT OR AGREEMENTS FOR THE RUNWAY 7/25 REHAB, PROJECT NO. 35293200, AS WELL AS THE REHABILITATE TAXIWAY A, PROJECT NO. 35293400, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Findlay is desirous to apply with the Ohio Department of Transportation (hereinafter referred to as ODOT) Aviation Airport Grant Program for the Runway 7/25 Rehab, Project No. 35293200, as well as the Rehabilitate Taxiway A, Project No. 35293400, and;


WHEREAS, the City of Findlay's allocation from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) will pay ninety percent (90%) of the project with ODOT's Airport Aviation Grant Program paying for an additional five percent (5%) of the project, reducing the City of Findlay's portion to only five percent (5%) of the construction costs.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor and/or Service Director of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and they are hereby authorized to apply for the Runway 7/25 Rehab, Project No. 35293200, as well as the Rehabilitate Taxiway A, Project No. 35293400 with the Ohio Department of Transportation Aviation Airport Grant Program, and if said grant is awarded to the City of Findlay, enter into an agreement or agreements.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to apply for said grant, and if awarded, enter into an agreement or agreements with the Ohio Department of Transportation Aviation Airport Grant Program so that said project may proceed.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
