

**ORDINANCE NO. 2020-048**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BUCKEYE PUMPS FOR REPAIRS AND/OR A REPLACEMENT PUMP, FOR THE BRIGHT ROAD PUMP STATION, WITHOUT THE NEED FOR FORMAL BIDDING AND ADVERTISING PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE §735.051, AND DECLARING A REAL AND PRESENT EMERGENCY.**


WHEREAS, there exists a real and present need to repair and/or replace said inoperable pump at the Water Pollution Control Center in order to restore the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Findlay and its citizenry and such repairs and/or replacement cannot be delayed by formal bidding and advertising.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Service Director be and he hereby is authorized to enter into a contract for repairs and/or a replacement pump for the Bright Road Pump Station as it directly relates to the state or condition of emergency and necessary to restore the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Findlay and its citizenry.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to obviate the need for formal bidding and advertising in order to restore the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Findlay and its citizenry.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
