ORDINANCE NO. 2020-104

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, OHIO TO APPLY FOR THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY'S TARGETED BROWNFIELD ASSESSMENT PROGRAM ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF FINDLAY, AND TO SIGN ALL NECESSARY AGREEMENTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City is desirous of applying for the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency's Targeted Brownfield Assessment (TBA) Program to help our municipality minimize the uncertainties of contamination of the property located at 1011 North Blanchard Street in Findlay, Ohio that is currently owned by Habitat for Humanity that is in need of assessment services related to said TBA, and;

WHEREAS, this program is coordinated directly through the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency with no funds being obtained by the City of Findlay, therefore, no matching funds are required by the City of Findlay, Ohio for said program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Findlay, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor of the City of Findlay, Ohio be and she is hereby authorized to apply for and sign the necessary agreement or agreements for the aforementioned TBA program.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Findlay, Ohio, and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to apply for and sign the aforementioned program application, as well as any necessary agreements, so that this assessment may proceed on an expedited basis.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
