### New Items

- 1. 525 & 529 Davis St Rezone
  - Request to rezone property to M2 Multi Family District, High Density from R2 Single Family, Low Density
  - City Planning Commission approved 3-0
  - Per Matt Cordonnier
    - Existing lots contain two duplexes; applicant desires to add a third duplex running parallel to the alley at the back of the lot; this necessitates the M2
    - Applicant will have to get some variances for density (considered minor) and possibly side-yard setback dependent upon placement of the new building
    - Some concerns were raised about emergency vehicle access however those concerns would not be made worse by the addition of the new building
    - No comments or concerns were received from the public about this application
  - Move to recommend approval as requested (Slough / Shindledecker)
    - Motion approved 3-0
- 2. 811 Broad Avenue Alley Vacation
  - Request to vacate the east-west alley running through the Croy business
  - City Planning Commission approved 2-1
    - Mayor Muryn opposed in favor of moving the alley
